When Lewis and Clark reached the Continental Divide, they expected to find a river that would allow them to paddle easily to the Pacific Ocean. What they saw instead were the Rocky Mountains – an unexpected series of challenges that pushed the boundaries of their strength and endurance. Minooka UMC has faced similar challenges for the last 40 months. When MUMC Church Conference approved the listing of our current property with a realtor (in November 2018), we expected to find a buyer within 6 months. Some people thought we should sell the current building before breaking ground on Ridge

Rd. As we paddled together and broke ground on Ridge Rd. anyway, the "For Sale" sign changed hands 3 times with 3 different realtors. Then, we encountered the Covid-19 pandemic. For the last two years, we have been paddling through the Rocky Mountains.

In the midst of the challenges, we stood firm. We remained steadfast and focused on the work of the Lord before us. In May 2021, Minooka UMC took the bold step of faith and broke ground on Ridge Rd. This past month (April 2022,) we signed the sales contract with Apostolic International Church. In a matter of months, we will move to a temporary worship space while our new home continues to be built.

Journeying through the Rocky Mountains seemed impossible, but God has blessed each step as we stayed faithful. I am grateful for the vision and perseverance of our Trustees and MUMC leadership team. Special thanks to Jim Satorius and Claude (Karen) Crawshaw for finding all necessary documents and communicating with our lawyer, Tim Malmquist, and relators, Kristian Lee and Lauren Grigus.

We have a lot of work to do over the next 90 days. We need to find (or build) storage space. We need to pack (or discard) worship furniture and office equipment. We need to find a place to keep the pipe organ and confirm a transitional place for worship services. While there is much to be done, I am confident that God, who has led us through the years, will continue to guide and lead us forward.

Thank you for being a congregation that embraces God's vision and passion for reaching a new generation for Christ. Thank you for your faithful prayers and ongoing support of our journey. Let's continue to stand firm on the promises of God and know that our labor in the Lord is not in vain. Let's continue to pursue God's vision for MUMC and the surrounding community.

While Spring and Winter battle it out, the pantry continues to deliver services efficiently and consistently. In addition, we are keeping an eye on the rising prices, but donations are keeping our shelves full. Also, we have just made connections with two other pantries, so the future looks bright.

Speaking of the future, we are planning for it. With the prospect of the church selling, we need to find a new location. Nothing definite yet, but we are working with another partner.

During COVID, we had to change to keep the pantry open and the way we supported the community. Today, we are back to our preferred way of running the pantry. But to do this in the future, we also need to increase our volunteer team. During COVID, I planned and bought the items to be distributed. With one or two volunteers, we packed the the food, came up with an organizational plan for pick up and did the actual pickup. Currently, the families come in and pick up their food, but we are operating on a minimal number of volunteers. I am still doing the shopping for the milk, eggs and any other items we need. Five of us are running the pantry with the generous help of donations by the community. My volunteers have been facing their own issues while trying to keep their commitment to the pantry. They have done this for three years. I think it is time to help them. They will continue to serve, but I am asking for more volunteers to lessen the time and workload for each person. So, if you can help, give your name to Katie in the office and we will contact you. With your help, the pantry will just get better.

Finally, the Pantry team would like to wish all the mothers a "Happy Mother's Day". Thank you for your support and generosity.


