After finalizing the sale on Nov 30, I found myself repeating the words of Job (42:2), "God, I know that You can do anything and no one can stop you!"

Praise God who makes all things possible! Praise God that – even in the midst of my doubts – the dreams that God sowed decades ago in MUMC are becoming reality. At times, I have to confess that God's plans for MUMC and for our community are just too wonderful for me to comprehend. 



Biggest TWO CHANGES that have occurred -Number 1 the selling of our church and a deposit of \$493,551 (Amen Amen) and — Number 2 the Red Door Loan from the Conference \$500,000 (Amen) these two changes allow Minooka United Methodist Church Construction to continue. Change number 2 included the word loan, and yes, starting in 2023 we will have a monthly payment of approximately \$3400. This means GROWTH is necessary for us to sustain our new Church.
