In January 2015, I received the good news that I would be appointed to Minooka UMC. Since then, Minooka UMC has been a haven for me and my family. Even though we all knew this season would end, it is much harder than I imagined. Today, I am a much better pastor and leader because of the love, care, and support I received at Minooka

UMC. When I was ordained in June of 2010, I vowed to be part of the itineracy, which means that I will go where I am sent by the Bishop and Cabinet. After much prayer, I accepted another call to serve two other churches (in Rockford, IL,) starting July 1st.

Therefore, I ask you not to contact me with pastoral care and/or church matters after June 30. You can share family updates but know that I will not respond. I will see and read your updates but will maintain pastoral boundaries. Starting July 1st, I encourage you to allow the newly appointed pastor to serve as the shepherd and spiritual leader of MUMC.

Transitions can be experienced as a crisis or opportunity. I am confident that this pastoral transition will be an opportunity for Minooka UMC. Over the last 8 years, we have dreamed together and experienced God's faithfulness together. We have prayed together, cried together, laughed together, and served together. Even as you pray for me, please know that I am praying for you and that MUMC has a special place in my heart. So, let us not be anxious, but trust in the faithfulness of God, who is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow.

On another note, Minooka UMC received 5 new members on April 23. We also celebrated 3 baptisms in April. May will be another exciting month as we celebrate Confirmands, baptisms, Mothers, and Sunday School teachers. I hope you will join us for these special worship services.

Thank you to our Transition Team and all of our volunteers for distributing door hangers at the end of April. We will continue to plan for a fun and exciting Open House at Ridge Road. Thank you to Chris Vause, Marlin Hartman, the Building & Trustee Committees, and all who have been working on the details of our move into Ridge Road. 




