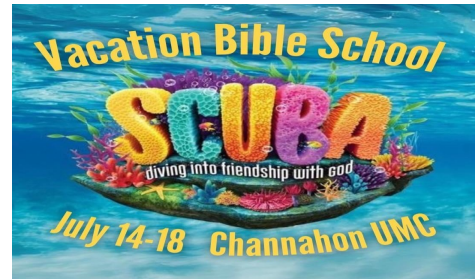
Thank you for your **prayers, presence, and gifts!**
